- AA: Alcoholics Anonymous is an open group for recovering alcoholics that meets in the HOPES third floor community room.
- ACA: Adults and Children of Alcoholics Meeting, HOPES 3rd floor community room.
- Accept: Free health education and risk reduction group, open to people of all genders living with HIV/AIDS and their loved ones. Located in HOPES 3rd floor community room, dinner is at 5, speakers start at 5:30.
- Al-anon: Women Only- Twelve Step, this meeting is open to the public and intended to support the friends and family of those affected by alcoholism. We meet in HOPES third floor community room.
- CAB: Community Advisory Board meets in the 3rd floor community room.
- Care Chest: Free medical resources for Nevadans in need including medical equipment/supplies, medical nutrition, prescription assistance, diabetic care supplies, and more. Please bring proof of residency and proof of income. The Care Chest Van will be parked on Ralston St.
- CMA: Crystal Meth Anonymous is an open group that meets in the HOPES community room on the third floor.
- Familias Hablando Unidas: Un programa disponerle a los padres de familia. El grupo discute temas como la importancia de la comunicación con su adolescente, los cambios y el desarrollo en la etapa del adolescente. - **Medicaid:** A representative from the Department of Welfare will be here all day to help with Medicaid enrollment. Appointments are preferred, please contact Intake (786-4673 option one or walk in) for more information and to schedule an appointment.
- NA: Narcotics Anonymous is an open group that meets on the third floor community room every week.
- **Re-Entry Support Group:** Have you experienced difficulties navigating your rights after incarceration? Come gather resources, learn about living with a criminal record and how to let your past empower your future. Food provided! Meet on the 3rd floor of HOPES.
- Senior Food Truck: Must be 60 or older to qualify, this truck will be parked on Ralston.
- **Sex +:** A safe and judgment-free place to discuss issues of sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, and kinks. We are here to promote open sexual attitudes in Northern Nevada. Meet on HOPES 3rd floor.
- **SNAP/Food Bank Mobile Pantry:** The Mobile Pantry program is a service program that distributes perishable foods. Our SNAP Outreach staff assists clients with the application process and conduct the in-person interview required to qualify for benefits.
